The Writing Spot Sequencing Assignments

In *Teaching the Universe of Discourse*, James Moffett advised teachers to progress from basic skills and forms to more academic writing. *The Writing Spot Big Book* and Buddy Book follow this organizational plan. This sequence helps students build writing skills and confidence.

The Writing Spot Yearlong Timetable

This suggested yearlong timetable presents one possible sequence of writing and language skills units based on a five-days-per-week class. The start of the year focuses on simple writing tasks, pairing them with skills activities. As the year progresses and students gain increasing fluency, they have more time and freedom to develop their writing projects.
